Family Fee

The 2023 Family Fee for St Francis of Assisi Primary School is \$2007.00 per year. This one fee is applicable no matter how many children you have attending the one school. Please refer to the table below for payment frequency options.

Student Fee

Year 4 Technology Fee

In 2022 the school absorbed the cost of a 1:1 iPad trial. The success of this in 2022 will see our 1:1 iPad program increased to Years 4-6 (previously only 5/6). In Year 4 from 2023 a technology levy has been added to the fee schedule which accounts for the higher fee increase in the table.

Example:

If you have a student in Foundation and Year 3 the yearly fee would be

Billing

Invoices will be prepared and sent at the start of the 2023 year. A Direct Debit form is attached or can be downloaded from the school website.

All existing Direct Debit arrangements will continue unless notice is given to the school.

Payment Arrangements

All families must complete the "Direct Debit Authority".

Scheduled payments will be set up by the school to pay either by Credit Card, or Direct Deposit.

Direct Debits will be set up at the start of the year for weekly (36 weeks), fortnightly (18 weeks), Monthly (9 months), each term (for 3 terms) or yearly payment options (1 payment in March).

Amounts will be calculated from your 2023 invoice, based on your payment option.

Centrepay is available for Centrelink recipients to have payments deducted from their benefits.

Any other payment methods not mentioned above must be discussed with the school principal and subject to approval.

Your Obligation

As part of your enrolment contract you have legally agreed to a financial commitment and are legally bound to pay fees and charges for your enrolled child.

In your enrolment application, you have nominated the person(s) who are responsible for the payment of fees, and what percentage each person(s) are responsible for.

For example: Person 1 is responsible for the payment of 50% of fees. and Person 2 is responsible for the payment of 50% of the fees – totalling 100%.

If the person(s) who are nominated to pay fees changes and/or the percentage each person(s) is nominated to pay changes, this must be communicated to the school in writing and signed by both parties.

The following Direct Debit payment frequencies are available for your convenience:

- Per week (36) Fridays
- Per fortnight (18) Fridays
- Per month (9) 15th of each Month
- Or** 28th February, 30th March to 30th October
- Per term (3) 30th of each Quarter, - March, June and September
- Annual (1) 30th of March

Fee Assistance

Parents who believe they may be unable to pay the fees are obliged to discuss this with the School Principal as soon as possible. Assistance may be available to families in cases of financial hardship.

PLEASE NOTE

Participation in the Year 3-6 camps are compulsory and a requisite to the school curriculum, fee refunds will not apply. Schools outlay a set amount to fund the provision of camps in their annual budget based on the full complement of students attending. Fee assistance may be available to cover the cost in part or full for families facing financial hardship.
